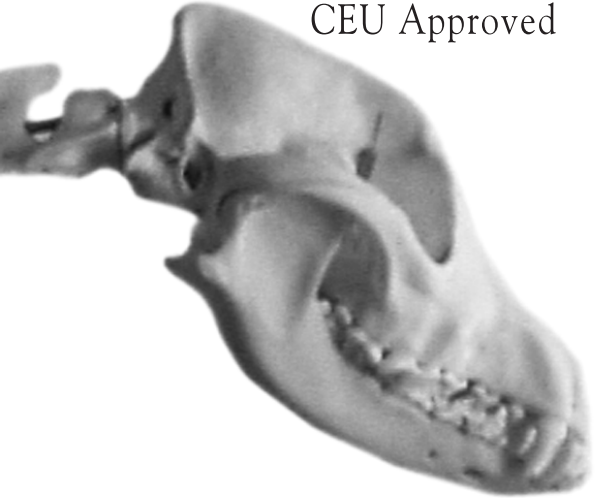

A four-day intensive tutorial in the diagnostic and therapeutic application of *functional (indirect) techniques* as applied to the cranio-sacral system.

These techniques use the principles of motion testing, inherent tissue motion and motion in relation to the restrictive barrier.

Comparisons between humans and animals.

Emphasis will be placed on palpatory skills.

This course will cover the following:

- ◆ Neuroanatomy of the cranio-sacral system of canines
- ◆ Arthrokinematics of the cranial bones
- ◆ Review of connective tissue interrelationships
- ◆ Cranio-sacral treatment as it intergrates with classic cranial osteopathy and the gait cycle
- ◆ Sequence of treatment
- ◆ Manipulation of neuro tissue, bloodvessels and nerves
- ◆ Neuro Integrational Patterns (NIP) - gait

Lecture, demonstration and hands on applied practice of the techniques for the following areas: cranium & pelvis for small animals.
