A 4-day intensive tutorial in the diagnostic and therapeutic application of *Animal Normalization Techniques (ANT)* as applied to the cranio-sacral system (cranial-ANT).

These techniques use the principles of motion testing, inherent tissue motion and motion in relation to the restrictive barrier. Comparisons between humans and animals. Emphasis will be placed on palpatory skills.

This course will cover the following:

- Neuro-anatomy of the cranio-sacral system of canines
- **Arthro-kinematics** of the cranial bones
- Review of connective tissue interrelationships
- Cranio-sacral treatment as it integrates with classic cranial osteopathy; relationship with Dura/Fascial lines & the gait cycle
- Sequence of treatment
- Manipulation of neuro tissue, blood/lymph vessels, and nerves
- Neuro Integrational Patterns (NIP) - gait

Lecture, demonstration, and hands-on applied practice of the techniques for the following areas: cranium & pelvis for small animals.
