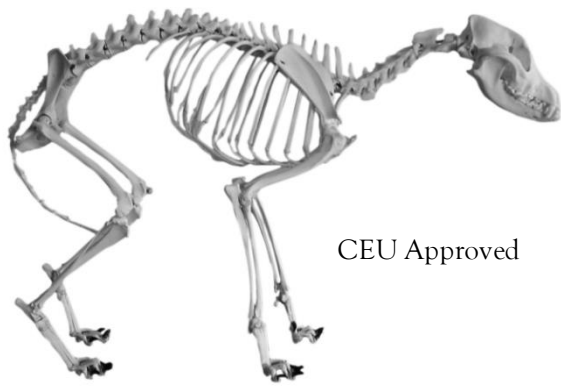

A 4-day intensive course in the diagnostic and therapeutic application of *Animal Normalization Techniques (ANT)* as applied to the superficial/deep lymph circulation and advanced techniques to address the vascular system in veterinary species. This is the course in the series and upon completion of this course and passing of the examination, students will achieve their **ANT Certification**, providing they have met all requirements.

These techniques use the principles of motion testing, inherent tissue motion and motion in relation to the restrictive barrier. Lecture, demonstration and hands-on applied practice of the techniques for the various regions will be given. Emphasis will be placed on palpation and manual skills.

This tutorial addresses **evaluation/treatment** of:

- Principles of osteopathy and review of previous ANT techniques
- Advanced lymphatics and vascular techniques
- Osteophones and use of tuning forks/crystals
- Fascial line techniques in relationship to fluid dynamics
- **Certification:** Two case studies, open book exam and practicum
- Class available for veterinarians, veterinary technicians, physical therapists and other health care providers
